- **Liferay Objects:** Use Objects to digitize real-world business entities like registration forms, service tickets, etc. Because Objects are seamlessly integrated with Liferay DXP's core functionality, you can build solutions tailored to your specific business needs easily.
- **Object Actions:** Define manual or automatic operations to be executed in response to event triggers. For example, when a new support ticket is submitted, Object Actions can be configured to automatically send an email to the support team.

Specify Object Actions to automate business processes.

• **Object Model Builder:** Leverage Model Builder to create and manage relationships between Objects via an intuitive, drag-and-drop UI. For example, users can create a relationship between an account Object and an account registration form Object so that information in the registration form is automatically associated with the correct account.

- Service-Level Agreement Definitions: Associate Objects with workflows and leverage workflow metrics to define and monitor service-level agreements. For instance, create a service-level agreement to ensure customer support tickets are addressed within twenty-four hours.
- **API Builder:** Employ Liferay DXP's built-in API Builder to create custom API schemas and define custom endpoints that meet your exact needs. API Builder makes it easy for external applications to consume Liferay DXP's services and enable headless experiences.
- **Client Extensions:** Extend Liferay DXP without impacting upgrades or maintainability with Client Extensions. Client Extensions enable teams to modify the behavior of their Liferay DXP application without modifying core code. Client Extensions can be written in familiar languages like JavaScript/CSS or Python, so teams don't need to write in Java or have any Liferay DXP-specific expertise.
