Historically...

Liferay was born as a **platform**
to build custom solutions

But it is becoming harder to achieve

Customer needs for these solutions have evolved, and **we need to outperform so we remain relevant** as a platform to create these new solutions with

Main challenges we face as a product

- **Customizations are required** because our current functionality **does not fully cover customers' needs** and use cases.
- These **customizations are difficult and expensive** since they require **DXP platform core modifications**. This causes **painful, expensive upgrades**, sometimes even harder than just migrating to other solution.
- Each **customization is one-off**, “lost” as it can't be easily re-used

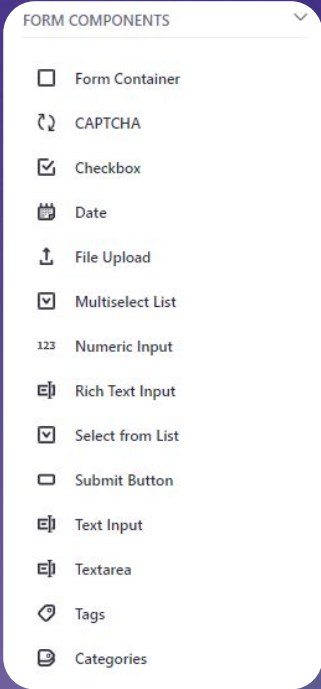

Better Release Reliability

Quarterly Releases

- **Starting Q3**, we are **adopting a Quarterly Release cycle**. Customers don't need to upgrade to receive fixes.
- Customers will receive patches against a quarterly release for 1 year.
- **Weekly updates maintained** our community accesses latest features weekly.



4 Quarterly Releases

Better Release Reliability

Walk towards **more consolidated stability** to increase trust and ease of **communication**.

Release feature flags for **better adoption of new features**. Flagged until publicly documented.

Beta features officially available. Policy in place (non-supported).
